Question Tag

The main points of the tag questions are:

1. A tag question is a short question that has two words (**helping verb**) and (**sub pronoun**) only with a question mark that follows the statement. (e.g. **have you? / haven't you?**)

- You haven't got a car, **have you?**
- It was a good film, **wasn't it?**

2. Normally we use a **positive question tag** with a **negative sentence**:

Negative sentence	Positive tag question
Tom won't be late,	will he?
They don't like us,	do they?
That isn't George over there,	is it?

3. And normally we use a **negative question tag** with a **positive sentence**:

Positive sentence	Negative tag question
Ann will be here soon,	won't she?
Tom should pass his exam,	shouldn't he?
They were very angry,	weren't they?

- **Note** → Negative must be **contracted** → (**aren't**) not (**are not**)
- **Note** → **I am** → **aren't I?** (e.g. I am late, **aren't I?**)

4. Helping verbs are (**be, have, do , modals**)

- **Be** → (is, are, am, was, were)
- **Have** → (have, has, had)
- **Do** → (do, does, did)
- **Modals** → (will, shall, can, must, would, should, could, have to, has to, had to)

5. Sub pronouns are (**he, she, it, they, we, you, I**)

6. What should we do if we **don't have a helping verb?**

- Examples:
- She **walks** on the wall easily, _____?
 - Sam **cancelled** the meeting, _____?
 - They **use** this machine daily, _____?

Main verb	Analyzing the verb	The answer
walks	does + walk	doesn't she?
cancelled	did + cancel	didn't he?
use	do + use	don't they?

7. With the sentence that starts with the word (**There**)

Examples:

- There are some students, **aren't there?**
- There is some milk in the fridge, **isn't there?**

8. Pay Attention to the verb (**have**)

- She **has called** you, **hasn't she?**
- She **has** a car, **doesn't she?**
- They **have used** it, **haven't they?**
- They **have** a nice garden, **don't they?**
- You **had joined** the team, **hadn't you?**
- You **had** a big house, **didn't you?**
